

More Details about our event:

All students are encouraged to participate. We understand not all families have the option not to drive to school. No matter how a student arrives at school this day consider registering for the event to automatically enter them into the drawing for prizes and encourage your student to stop by the table before and after school for the following:

- Snacks and refreshments before and after school
- Decorate your own helmet station (even if you didn't wear it to school, bring it with you to decorate for later)
- Stickers, participation certificates and other give aways
- Enter the drawing for even more prizes by pledging to have a conversation with family about replacing one car trip with alternative locomotion one time this week. This could include a walk, bike ride, public transportation, etc.

Volunteers will be on site by 6:30am. If your child receives before or after care through the YMCA they will still have the opportunity to participate in the event. <u>Coffee for parents will be available at 8:00am</u>
