About the Class: Learn to Type Faster, Easier, and Better!

Join Palmer's after school typing club and learn to type at your own pace with gamified lessons and student-led progression in a friendly and fun environment.

The objective of this club is to develop and increase students' keyboarding skills. (the ability to input information at a keyboard smoothly while typing) along with speed (efficiency), accuracy (focus), and productivity. Students will use the touch-typing technique method of typing (with all the available fingers without looking at the keyboard). In addition, they will learn how to maintain healthy posture, familiarization with the keyboard layout, pressing each key with the proper finger and by the same finger all the time.

During the 10 weeks period students will take several typing speed tests to keep track of their progress and participate in a friendly competition. (Breaks and other activities provided to keep things going)
