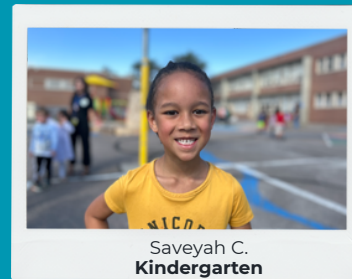
MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

PALMER SCHOOL EXPLORATION EVENT

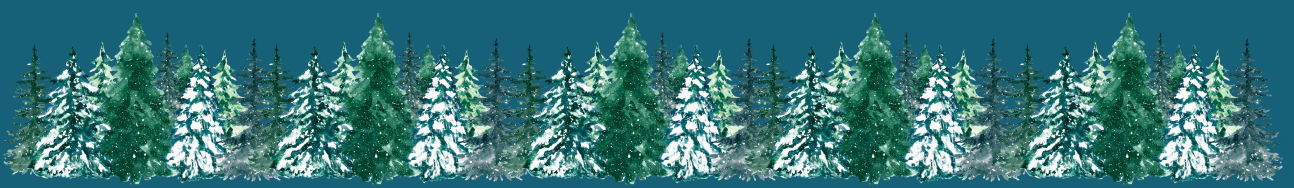
